THE CITY OF REDLANDS IS PURCHASING ENGLAND GROVE, A 6.84-ACRE CITRUS GROVE AT THE CORNER OF PALM AVENUE AND ALVARADO STREET. THE LAND WILL BE PRESERVED AND FARMED AS PART OF THE CITY'S CITRUS LEGACY PROGRAM.

WHY IT MATTERS

THE PURCHASE OF ENGLAND GROVE IS PART OF THE CITY'S COMMITMENT TO PRESERVING REDLANDS' AGRICULTURAL HERITAGE. AS PART OF THE SALE, THE PROPERTY WILL BE REPLANTED WITH 784 NEW ORANGE TREES & UPGRADED WITH A MODERN IRRIGATION SYSTEM TO SUPPORT SUSTAINABLE FARMING.
