NOTICE is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, will hold a public hearing to consider the following:

PUBLIC HEARING to consider **Ordinance No. 2994** To amend various sections of the Redlands Municipal Code as follows:

- Amending Chapter 15.04 of the Redlands Municipal Code relating to the adoption of the 2025 California Building Code, volumes 1 and 2, including chapters 1, 9, 15, 31 and 33, as amended, and appendices G, H, I and J, as amended, are adopted as the building code of the city and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of such uniform code and amendments are referred to and made a part of this Chapter as currently adopted.
- Amending Chapter 15.06 of the Redlands Municipal Code relating to the adoption of the 2025 California Residential Code with local amendments, including chapters 1, 3, and 9 as amended, and appendices BF, BJ, BO, and CI are adopted as the residential building code of the city and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of such residential building code and amendments are referred to and made a part of this Chapter as currently adopted.
- Amending Chapter 15.08 of the Redlands Municipal Code relating to the adoption of the 2025 California Plumbing Code with local amendments, including chapters 1,6 and 7 as the plumbing code of the city and all regulations, provisions, conditions, and terms of such plumbing code and amendments as referred to and made a part of this Chapter as currently adopted.
- Amending Chapter 15.10 of the Redlands Municipal Code relating to the adoption of the 2025 California Electrical Code with local amendments, including articles 89 and 90 (as amended), are adopted as the electrical code of the city and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of the electrical code and all amendments are referred to and made a part of this Chapter as currently adopted.
- Amending Chapter 15.12 of the Redlands Municipal Code relating to the adoption of the 2025 California Mechanical Code, as the mechanical code of the City and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of such are adopted and made part of this Chapter.
- Amending Chapter 15.16 of the Redlands Municipal Code relating to the adoption of the 2025 California Green Building Standards Code, as the green building code of the City and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of such are adopted and made part of this Chapter.
- Amending Chapter 15.18 of the Redlands Municipal Code relating to the adoption of the 2025 California Energy Code is adopted as the energy code of the City and all of the regulations, provisions, conditions and terms of such are adopted and made part of this Chapter.
- Amending Chapter 15.22 of the Redlands Municipal Code relating to the adoption of the 2025 California Historical Building Code as the historical building code of the City and all regulations, provisions, conditions, and terms of such are adopted and made a part of this Chapter.
- Amending Chapter 15.23 of the Redlands Municipal Code relating to the adoption of the 2025 California Existing Building Code as the historical building code of the City and all regulations, provisions, conditions, and terms of such are adopted and made a part of this Chapter.
