



CITY OF REDLANDS CITY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Redlands City Council will hold a Public Hearing to receive public comment and consider the introduction of Ordinance 2986 for the Fire Hazard Severity Zone (FHSZ) Map designation as recommended by the State Fire Marshal pursuant to California Government Code Section 51178, in accordance with the requirements of Government Code Section 51179. The State Fire Marshal has provided updated Fire Hazard Severity Zone designations for 2025. In accordance with Government Code Section 51179(a), the City is required to adopt by ordinance the moderate, high, and very high fire hazard severity zones within 120 days of receiving the recommendations. The adoption of the Fire Hazard Severity Zone Map will: Designate moderate, high, and very high fire hazard severity zones within the District boundaries; Incorporate any findings and recommendations necessary for effective fire protection, as supported by substantial evidence in the record; Comply with all requirements and limitations under Government Code Section 51179, including the prohibition of reducing zone designations identified by the State Fire Marshal.


NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that all property owners having any objections to adoption of the Ordinance are hereby notified to attend a public hearing of the Redlands City Council to be held on **July 1, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. in the Redlands City Council Chambers of Redlands City Hall, located at 35 Cajon Street, Ste. 2, Redlands, California 92373** when and where objections will be heard and given due consideration.

Due to time constraints and the number of persons wishing to give oral testimony, time restrictions may be placed on oral testimony at the hearing regarding this project.
