



City of Redlands City Council Notice of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Redlands will hold a Public Hearing in the Civic Center, 35 Cajon Street, Suite 2, on **Tuesday, February 3, 2026, beginning at 6:00 p.m.** or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

1. Consideration of a Notice of Exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections: 15061(b)(3) because the proposal will not result in any potentially significant environmental effects; and 15378(b)(5) for organizational and administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment.
2. **PUBLIC HEARING** to consider a recommendation to the City Council on **Ordinance No. 2999 and Resolution No. 8747** for Ordinance Text Amendment No. 371 – A proposal to amend the following sections of the Zoning Regulations (Title 18) of the Redlands Municipal Code and residential Specific Plans in the City: amend Section 18.29.030 to allow up to three chickens (hens only) on lots between 4,000 to 7,200 square feet, allow up to four hens on lots between 7,201 to 9,999 square feet, allow up to five hens on lots between 10,000 to 20,000 square feet, and related minor text changes; and amend Sections 18.20.030, 18.21.030, 18.24.030, 18.28.035, 18.29.030, 18.32.025, 18.36.025, 18.40.040, and Specific Plans to allow the incidental keeping of chickens (hens only) in all single-family districts in accordance with RMC Section 18.29.030.
3. Consideration of **Ordinance No. 2999** to amend the following sections of Title 6 (Animals) of the Redlands Municipal Code: Section 6.24.030 for development standards pertaining to the keeping of chickens (hens only) and incidental sale of eggs; and Sections 6.24.020 and 6.24.070 for other minor text amendments.
