HUMAN RELATIONS COMMISSION

2.66.010 Established:

There is a human relations commission established to serve in an advisory capacity to the city council and to aid the city in achieving better human relations by providing assistance to all persons or groups in promoting goodwill and better relations among all people.

2.66.050 Powers, Duties And Responsibilities:

The powers, duties and responsibilities of the commission shall include, but are not necessarily limited to, the following:

- A. To foster mutual respect and understanding with regard to race, religion, national origin, age, gender, disability or other minority affiliation;
- B. To undertake such studies in any field of human relationship in the community as in the judgment of the commission will aid in effectuating its general purposes;
- C. To recommend such educational programs as, in the judgment of the commission, will increase goodwill among inhabitants of the community and open new opportunities into all phases of community life for all inhabitants;
- D. To hold public meetings, in the interest of the constructive resolution of prejudice and discrimination occasioned thereby;
- E. To issue such publications and reports as in its judgment will tend to effectuate the purposes of this chapter;
- F. To enlist the cooperation and participation of the various racial and nationality groups, community organizations, industry and labor organizations, media or mass communication, fraternal and benevolent associations, and other groups in an educational campaign devoted to fostering among the diverse groups of the community mutual esteem, justice and equity;
- G. To recommend to the city council that agencies under the jurisdiction of the city take such action as will fulfill the purposes of this chapter;
- H. To submit an annual report to the city council.

PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION

2.32.010 Existence.

There is a parks and recreation advisory commission established to make recommendations and advise the city council regarding parks, parkways, street trees and recreation

2.32.050 Duties.

The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission shall recommend to the city council policies for the acquisition, development, maintenance and improvement of parks, public trails and open space areas, and for the planting, care and removal of landscaping and amenities in all parks, public trails and open space areas. In addition, the commission shall have the following duties relating to recreation:

- A. Use the commissioners' skills, knowledge and experience to assist and advise the city recreation division staff;
- B. Keep the public informed about the city's recreation program;
- C. Serve as a forum for the promotion of activities for the recreation division and the city's community center;
- D. Serve as a forum for residents' suggestions, reactions, opinions, interests and needs regarding the city's recreation division and its programs.

TRAFFIC AND PARKING COMMISSION

2.48.010 Existence:

There is established a traffic and parking commission of the city to serve in an advisory capacity to the city council

2.48.040 Duties:

It shall be the duty of the traffic and parking commission to perform educational activities in traffic matters, to supervise the preparation and publication of traffic reports, to receive complaints relating to traffic matters and to recommend to the city council ways and means of improving traffic conditions and the administration and enforcement of traffic regulations.

The traffic and parking commission shall also advise the city council on the development of adequate parking for commercial and retail uses, recommend policies to encourage, develop and support adequate parking within the city, recommend actions for the establishment of long term parking plans for the city and in particular the downtown Redlands business area, and advise the city council in the administration of resources for the development of parking. The commission may also assist other advisory groups such as the planning commission in matters relating to parking.

The commission shall keep records of all of its acts and proceedings, and shall submit all of its recommendations to the city council and to the city manager.
